I have been working in the field of drugs and drug policy for over 15 years - initiating and developing harm reduction services organization, supporting community building and advocating for quality and sustainability of services. I am a founder and Executive Director of PREKURSOR Foundation for Social Policy - a leading NGO, based in Warsaw, which runs the biggest harm reduction program in Poland and the only one in the capital, providing support and needs-based assistance offers for people who use drugs. The PREKURSOR Foundation of non-governmental organizations and individuals working in the field of public health and social policy, aiming to initiate debate on crucial policy issues like the crossroad of psychoactive substance use, sexual health, public health, social policy and social exclusion. The organization conducts activities in the area of harm prevention and harm reduction in the context of substance use and sexual behaviours, HIV/HCV and STIs prevention and treatment, drug policy, homelessness, sexual education, mental health. PREKURSOR works with various vulnerable populations – PWUD, sex workers, migrants, youth at risk, inmates.

I have a good understanding of the situation of PWUD in the region which is crucial in searching for and implementing the most effective solutions.
